Role and Responsibilities

The Tester / Developer will report to the Technical Manager of the Secretariat of the Association, and he/she will be responsible of the following functions:

1) As a Developer:

- Participate in the writing of the specifications of the software to be developed.
- Produce clean, efficient code based on specifications.
- Integrate software components and third-party programs.
- Troubleshoot, debug and upgrade existing software.

2) As a Tester:

- Planning tests, designing and preparing tests cases/scripts/data/environments.
- Executing tests, reporting issues/defects, and verifying fixes.
- Reporting test results.

3) Also:

- Gathering and evaluating user feedback.
- Recommending and executing improvements.
- Maintaining and upgrading existing systems.
- Deploying software tools, processes, and metrics.
- Training users.
- Creating technical documentation for reference and reporting.

In addition, it is expected that the Tester / Developer will also have the following qualities:

- Attention to detail and outstanding analytical and problem-solving abilities.
- Knowledge and interest in computer systems and the latest technologies.
- The ability to learn new languages and technologies quickly.
- An analytical mind.
- Resourcefulness and troubleshooting aptitude.
- Good communication skills both written and verbal.
- The ability to communicate complex procedures to other colleagues.
- Good collaboration and teamwork abilities.
- Commercial and business awareness.
